Originally formed as the New York Sketch Club in 1871, Salmagundi is one of the oldest art organizations in America, and is housed in the last remaining brown-stone on Fifth Avenue, built in 1854.

Through the years, Salmagundi has been the gathering place for such great artists as Childe Hassam, William Merritt Chase, N.C. Wyeth, Louis Comfort Tiffany, and Ogden Pleisner. Salmagundi is a fellowship dedicated to the promotion and enjoyment of the fine arts. Salmagundians, in casual and formal evenings, come together as makers of art and friends of art, bound by a mutual pleasure in the highest traditions of American painting and sculpture.

Year round programs for exhibitions and events keep the galleries, library, lounge and meeting rooms alive with activity for visitors as well as members and their friends. Today, the premises not only serves as a spectacular gallery for contemporary artists to show their work but is also home to exhibits by The American Watercolor Society, The American Artists Professional League and The Audubon Artists Society. We host a minimum of two events, yearly, which are open to all artists. And, in addition to lectures and demonstrations that are open to the public, we are among the few studios that continues to offer walk-in art classes.
